- Tackle any potential bullying by letting teachers know if there is an issue

- Get to know about their life at school and encourage them to take an active interest in the school's extra-curricular programme

- Understand that any forms of bullying will not be tolerated
- Attend re-admission meetings or other meetings requested by the school
