Entry Requirements for 2024

We offer 35 different academic and vocational courses. Students study 3 subjects in year 12 as part of their programme of study and can study 4 if they wish to. To support students in trying to ensure success all programmes of study require the following standard entry requirements:

• 6 GCSE Grade 4-9 including English & Mathematics

- Students who fail exams in Year 12 subjects may not be permitted to continue in that subject to Year 13.
