<p>Topics:</p> <p>Specific topics are dependent on tier.</p>	<p>Algebra – Sequences, Solving equations, expanding and factorising, drawing straight line graphs, forming expressions, simultaneous equations.</p> <p>Number – Percentages, ratio, standard form, error intervals, indices, HCF/LCM, ordering numbers, adding/subtracting fractions, rounding.</p> <p>Shape, space and measure – similar shapes, transformations, area/perimeter of 2D shapes, volume, surface area, angle facts, constructing and measuring angles.</p>
