



Subject and university reviews


As well as talking through your ideas and plans with family, friends, teachers or advisers, you can find other opinions online. Take the time to check what other people through by visiting the following:


- Get a student viewpoint at <u>Unistats</u>

- 4 Look at the government's <u>Teaching Excellence Framework (TEF)</u> for ratings on teaching quality, learning environment, as well as student outcomes.






