# Qualification requirements

UCAS Tariff 120 - 128 points

Do your predicted grades 'fit' the course requirement?

Required subjects in Sixth Form

120-128 tariff points including a minimum of 2 A-levels or equivalent, including 40 points in 1 required subject Extended Diploma: DDM in a required subject.

Required subjects: One creative subject such as: Fine Art, Photography, Media Design or Product Design and one technical subject such as: Maths, Computing or Physics.

128 tariff points in a required subject.

118 - 128 tariff points in a required subject with any combination of Distinction, Merit, Pass grades

120 - 128 tariff points including a minimum of 2 Principal Subjects in required subjects (52 points in 1 required subject).

Accepted as part of the overall tariff but it must be accompanied by 2 A-levels or equivalent

GCSE/National 4/National 5 GCSE English and Maths grade C (or grade 4 in the reformed GCSE grade)

Y13 GCE / BTEC results
