- Some subjects not studied at GCSE Level may, with Teacher approval, be taken at A Level.
- In addition to the above courses, students who do not achieve a Grade 4 in English and/or Mathematics GCSE will be required to re-sit to achieve a pass and increase options post 18 and access higher education
- Some GCSE's (including Business Studies, Design & Technology, Media and Psychology) are still being graded using letters. A*-C is the expected standard but please see individual subjects.
- Vocational qualifications graded at Pass, Merit, Distinction & Distinction* will be considered as part of any application.
- Students who fail exams in Year 12 subjects may not be permitted to continue in that subject to Year 13.
- We can not guarantee all course will run. However, if you start the course we will support you to complete the full qualification.
