## The 16 to 19 Tuition Fund 2021 to 2022

### Policy Details:

We will use reports from our data system and the 2021 Census to identify learners who are eligible for support, using the criteria set by the ESFA. We will review at a subject level those learners whose progress has been impacted by the effects of the pandemic.

We will consider at a subject level how best to deliver small group or 1 to 1 additional support in line with student needs and available resources.

We will use the Tuition fund to facilitate small group learning using a variety of options depending on availability of existing teaching staff and the timing of the required intervention. We will use existing teaching staff to deliver additional support and if necessary provide additional learning resources to support the learning of eligible students.

We are prioritising students in the following way:

**Priority 1** Learners with a 3 or Lower GCSE Pass in English Language OR Mathematics

**Priority 2** Learners with a 4 at GCSE English Language or Maths who we have identified where progress has been impacted by the pandemic.

**Priority 3** Learners from a Postcode which attracts Block 1 disadvantage Funding from the ESFA.

We use an outside agency to support us in identifying Priority learners.
