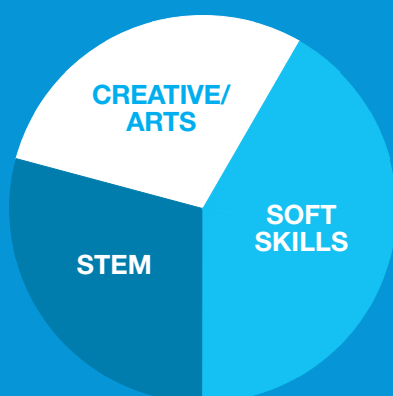

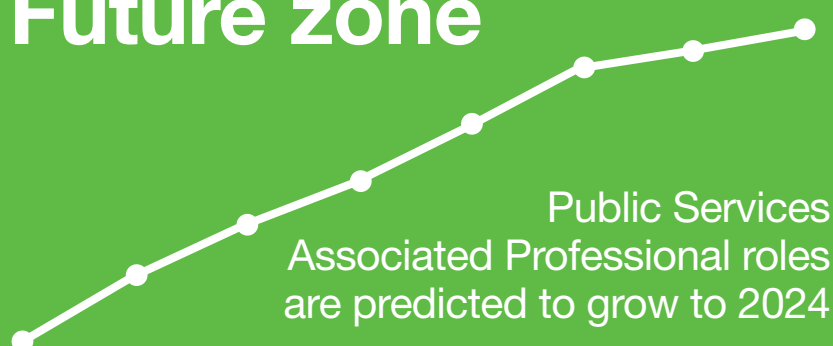

1.3m jobs or 27% of public sector workforce are in admin or operative roles and have a 77% chance of being automated

2.6m or 52% of workforce require personal interaction and have a 23% chance of being automated and 1.0m jobs are cognitive roles which have a 14% chance of being automated
