Level 3 BTEC Extended Certificate or Diploma

Course objectives

The BTEC Performing Arts course is a practical course based around musical theatre. Students will be taught acting, dance and singing and investigate existing repertoire and practitioners.

Main qualifications

- BTEC Level 3 Extended Certificate or Diploma

Awarding Body

- Pearson

Duration/ Lessons per week

- 10 x 1 hour lessons over a two week timetable

Entry requirements

- Standard entry requirements for vocational course.
- Audition
- Proficiency in acting, singing and dancing
- OR audition for external candidates

Progression opportunities

- Theatre Schools for training in musical theatre
- Degrees in Performing Arts/Musical Theatre
- BTEC Level 3s are valued by employers and higher education (university and colleges).
- Both the extended certificate and the diploma can be studied alongside other BTEC courses or A-Levels.
- The diploma supports progression into apprenticeship in Performing Arts or further study, at college or University.



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Course content

Compulsory Units

- Extended Certificate:

Developing skills and techniques for live performance
Group Performance Workshop
- Diploma:
Performing Arts in the community
Individual performance commission
Final live performance to an audience
- Other units:
Movement in performance
Musical theatre technique
Singing techniques for performers
Acting styles

Assessment

- Some external assessment; coursework; performances.
- No final exams.
- All work is graded at Pass, Merit or Distinction. Each grade has a point score and the overall qualification grade is the total point score which, if all units are of distinction standard, can be a Distinction*.

Costs

- Residential visit to London October 2022.
At approx. £300
- Around £100 per year for theatre visits.
