

In Year 9 everyone will study...






- English

How will I make my choice?

PE & Performing Arts

How do I opt once I have chosen?



- You will be asked to select your choices during your ITaCs lessons at the start of May.
- You will use an online form.
- I will ask for your 3 choices and a reserve choice.
- This is because there are limits to the number of students who can be in some subjects.
- Spanish if you wish to take Spanish in Year 10 & 11, you MUST take this in Year 9. This is not the same for the other courses.
